A PROCLAMATION

CÉCILE E. F. LA GRENADE Governor-General

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 52 of the Constitution of Grenada that the Governor-General may at any time prorogue or dissolve Parliament;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (4) of section 52 of the said Constitution of Grenada that in the exercise of his powers to dissolve Parliament the Governor-General, shall act in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister;

AND WHEREAS the Prime Minister has advised me that Parliament should be dissolved on Monday the 16th day of May, 2022;

NOW THEREFORE, I CÉCILE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid and acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister do hereby dissolve Parliament on Monday the 16th day of May, 2022.

AND the Members of the Senate and the House of Representatives and all other of Her Majesty's Officers and loving subjects in Grenada, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.
