This booklet provides useful information on scholarships available to Caribbean students for study in the 27 Member States of the European Union. The booklet includes information on study in each of the 27 countries along with information on our flagship Erasmus+ programme.

#### WHY STUDY IN EUROPE?

Experience an excellent higher education in Europe and benefit from an extensive choice of bachelor and master courses, doctoral study programmes, and more. In Europe, students also have the opportunity to explore diverse languages and cultures in a welcoming, social environment, while gaining international experience, skills and knowledge!

#### SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

There are hundreds of scholarships and financial support schemes available for international students who wish to study in European Union Member States. Some schemes cover part of the tuition fees whereas some cover all of the tuition fees along with living costs. Competition can be strong, but it is well worth exploring your options.



#### Costs

Studying in the European Union (EU) can be very cost-effective. European countries invest in their higher education systems to help make education affordable for students, whilst maintaining high quality standards.

Each EU Member State has its own fee policy but in general, tuition fees are lower than in other leading study destinations. In fact, in some EU countries, study programmes are free of charge! #### WORKING WHILE STUDYING

Many students work part-time whilst they study or during their university holidays to help support themselves financially.





#### VISA REQUIREMENTS


Most countries allow students on a visa to work part-time, but some countries place restrictions on the amount of hours that visa-holders can work. #### STUDENT SCHENGEN VISA

A Student Schengen Visa is an entry permit to the Schengen Zone, granted to thirdcountry nationals wishing to enter and remain for short-stays in any of the member states, under the purpose of studying. The Schengen area includes both EU and non-EU Member States. This visa permits its holder to remain in the Schengen territory for a



maximum of three months. If your study or training course lasts longer than that, you should apply for a Long-Stay Study Visa at the embassy of the respective country. Note: The citizens of several Caribbean countries do not require a Schengen visa.

#### FRASMUS+

Erasmus+ is the EU programme for education, training, youth and sport for the period 2014-2020. Erasmus+ funds academic mobility and cooperation projects that involve partners from "Programme Countries" and "Partner



Countries" throughout the world. For over 30 years, students and staff have moved between European universities in the Erasmus programme. Since 2015, the Erasmus+ programme has also allowed short-term mobility to Europe for students, researchers and staff from the whole world in order to study or train in two or more European countries at bachelor and master's level or other vocational purposes.

#### **ERASMUS MUNDUS JOINT MASTERS DEGREES**

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees (EMJMDs) award EU-funded scholarships to Master students from around the world that cover tuition, travel, and a living allowance. The programmes last from one to two years during which students study in at least two different European countries, and obtain a joint, double degree, or multiple degree. The Erasmus+ Catalogue is updated yearly. Most consortia require applications to be submitted between October and January for courses starting the following academic year. Students should contact the relevant consortium directly for information on courses, application procedures, and scholarships availability. Since 2014, over 250 Caribbean students have undertaken Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees.

#### **EUROCULTURE ERASMUS MUNDUS STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Erasmus Mundus Programme provides EU-funded scholarships for Third Country students and EU and European Economic Area (EEA) students who have applied to and have been accepted by the Euroculture Master Course. There are around 22 grants available each year.

#### INTERNATIONAL CREDIT MOBILITY

The two-way mobility of Erasmus+ allows students to study in a foreign university for three to 12 months and obtain credits, which are then recognised at the sending institution as part of their degree. Since 2016, over 1,000 Caribbean students and staff have benefitted from academic mobility programmes.



#### STUDY IN AUSTRIA

The Austria Development Cooperation offers Fully Funded Scholarships in Austria for pursuit of Bachelor, Masters, PhD, and Postdoctoral Programmes. Scholarships cover the cost of a student's participation in the programme, travel and a living allowance.

# STUDY IN CROATIA

To study at Croatian higher education institutions, international students must have sufficient financial means for the duration of their stay in Croatia from personal sources or scholarships sources. Some Croatian higher education institutions might offer some financial aid or partial tuition fee waivers for international students. However, there are a number of scholarships available for exchange or degree students through bilateral scholarships and Erasmus+.

Danish universities receive a limited number of government scholarships each year to fund highly qualified full-degree students from non-EU/EEA countries. The Danish Government Scholarship is granted either as full or partial tuition fee waivers and/or as an amount, that covers basic living costs.

#### FUNDING FOR 3-12 MONTH EXCHANGE AND STUDY ABROAD OPPORTUNITIES

Through Erasmus+, international students can study in one of 33 European Erasmus+ programme countries for between 3 – 12 months as part of their study programme. As part of the scheme, students do not have to pay tuition fees for their time abroad. Some students may also be eligible for a grant contributing to living costs and travel expenses.
