Your Memorandum of 2nd June 2023 on the above-captioned subject refers.

I wish to respond as follows:

Question No. 1.

a. Will the Minister of Finance provide the Honourable House with a list of the names of each delegation who travelled on behalf of the Government of Grenada from 23rd June 2023 to 31st May 2023.

This information is not available within the Ministry of Finance as the Ministry of Finance is not responsible for the approval of travel across the Government service. The Ministry of Finance will undertake to research this information but cannot provide a defined timeframe for the submission of the information.

Question No. 2.

b. Will the Minister of Finance inform this Honourable House of the total cost of each trip? In the event that the total cost was not borne by the Government in some cases, can the Minister inform the House who paid for these trips?

The total cost of each trip is not readily available within the Ministry of Finance. That said, the Ministry of Finance can provide the total cost of travel paid out of the Consolidated Fund by month or year to date, if requested.

The details of official Government travel paid outside of the Consolidated Fund is not available within the Ministry of Finance. The Ministry of Finance will undertake to research this information but cannot provide a defined timeframe for the submission of the information.
