A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the nation of Grenada has marked and celebrated 50 years of independence on 7th February 2024;

WHEREAS the people of Grenada desire that the contribution of persons to the development of Grenada be demonstrably celebrated, emulated, and recognised;

WHEREAS in Grenada's pre-Independence and post-Independence history outstanding sons and daughters have served, sacrificed and won acclaim and recognition for Grenada, such that they have inspired the nation and have won the admiration and acknowledgement of all for their bravery, courage, outstanding achievements, noble deeds, and sacrifices;

WHEREAS in remembrance of, reflection on and recognition of the strides of the nation and people of Grenada in recovery and growth and to promote unity and our advancement as one people, the Government of Grenada has decided to observe October 19, as "National Heroes Day", a Bank Holiday in Grenada;

AND WHEREAS it is enacted by section 7 of the Bank Holidays Act, Chapter 25, that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General from time to time by Proclamation in the *Gazette* to appoint a special day or part thereof to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada;

NOW THEREFORE, I, CÉCILE ELLEN FLEURETTE LA GRENADE, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada, do hereby appoint Saturday, October 19, 2024, to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Grenada to commemorate “National Heroes Day”, and hereby call on all citizens of Grenada, to participate in the activities planned for commemorating National Heroes Day.
