Grenada Postal Corporation Temporarily Suspends Parcel Shipments to the United States

St. George's, Grenada – August 28, 2025 – The Grenada Postal Corporation (GPC) announces the **temporary suspension of all parcels and small package shipments containing goods to the United States**, effective immediately.

This action follows the U.S. Government's **Executive Order 14324**, which **eliminates the long-standing duty-free exemption (de minimis) of US\$800** on shipments entering the United States.

Beginning **August 29, 2025**, all goods entering the U.S. will be subject to customs duties **from the first dollar**.

KEY IMPACT FOR CUSTOMERS:

- **All parcels and small packages containing goods to the U.S. are suspended.**
- **Only documents (letter mail without goods) will continue to be accepted.**
- **Senders must now prepay customs duties**, shifting responsibility from the recipients.
- **Every shipment must be pre-filed electronically** with U.S. Customs, using their new documentation requirements.

This unprecedented change has created **global disruptions**: postal operators across **Europe, Asia, and the Caribbean** are similarly suspending services due to unresolved aspects of these new requirements.

Next Steps:

- GPC is actively working with the **Universal Postal Union and international partners** to develop compliant solutions.
- GPC remains committed to restoring parcel services to the U.S. **as soon as operationally feasible**.

Message to Customers:

GPC deeply regrets the inconvenience caused by this suspension but emphasizes that the action is necessary to ensure **compliance with U.S. regulations** and to protect customers from disruptions.
