A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 52 of the Constitution of Grenada that the Governor-General may at any time prorogue or dissolve Parliament;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Parliament be prorogued from the 29th day of August 2025;

NOW THEREFORE, I Cécile La Grenade, Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General in and over Grenada, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue the Parliament of Grenada from the 29th day of August 2025, until such further date as may be appointed.

AND MEMBERS of the said Parliament and all other of His Majesty's officers and loving subjects in Grenada, and all other whom it may concern, are hereby required to take due notice thereof and give their ready obedience accordingly.

GIVEN under my hand and the Public Seal of Grenada, this ^{22nd} day of August, Two Thousand and Twenty-Five in the third year of the reign of **HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES THE THIRD**.
